

Space Line-Ups

This resource focuses on ordinal numbers and positional language which can pose some difficulties for younger pupils and SEN pupils.

This pack includes three worksheets for pupils to practise these essential skills. Objects with a space theme have to be cut, practising fine motor skills, and placed in the correct positions using the instructions.

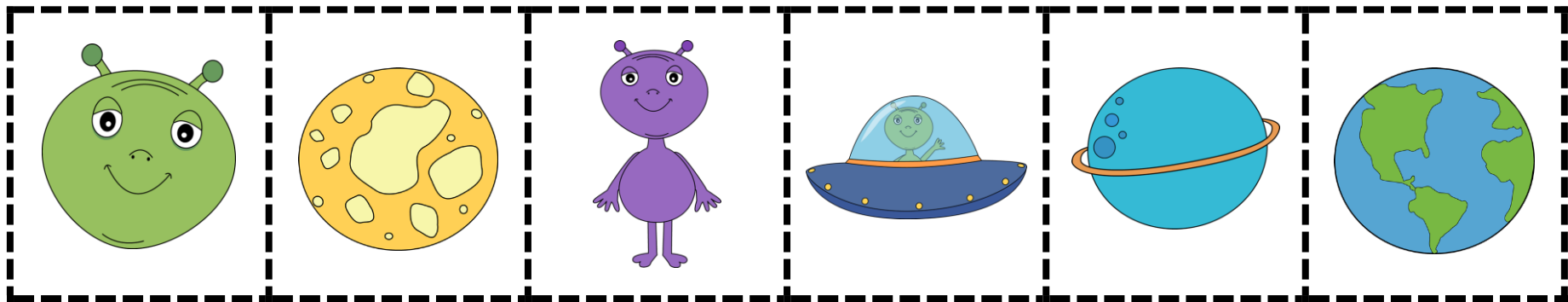
The worksheets include language like first, last, third, before, beside, between.

If the pupils are able, they can read the instructions independently and follow the directions. Alternatively, the teacher can read the directions aloud and pupils follow the directions accordingly.

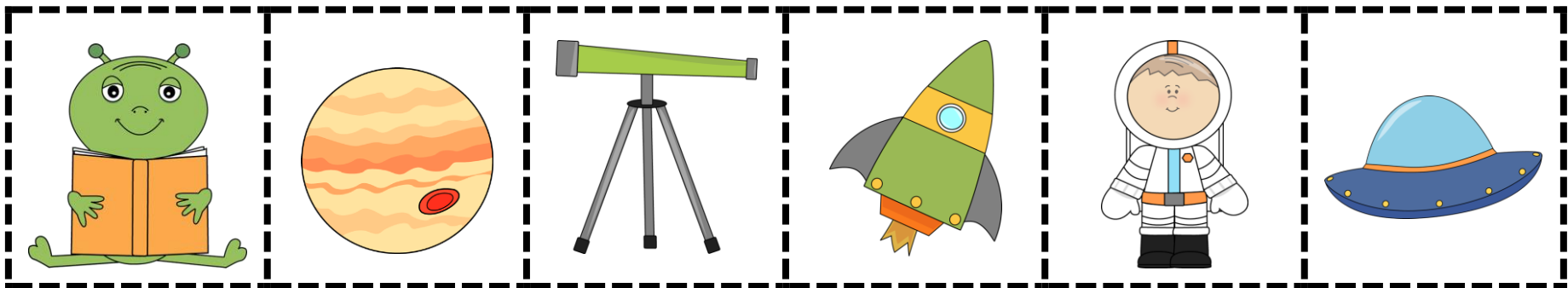
1. The yellow moon is first in line.
2. The UFO is third in line.
3. The earth is after the UFO .
4. The purple alien is last in line.
5. The green alien is after the yellow moon.
6. The blue planet is between the earth and the purple alien.



Space Line-Up

1. The UFO is first in line.
2. The rocket is third in line.
3. Jupiter is after the rocket.
4. The green alien is last in line.
5. The telescope is after the UFO.
6. The astronaut is between Jupiter and the green alien.



Space Line-Up

1. The green alien is last in line.
2. The blue star is fourth in line.
3. The green planet is before the star.
4. The asteroid is first in line.
5. The yellow moon is between the blue star and the green alien
6. The purple alien is after the asteroid.
