these.



hat

You wear this on your
head to keep your head
and ears warm.



crayon

You can use this to
colour in a picture.



bow

You stick this on the top
of a present for
decoration.



lime

This is a juicy fruit which
can be quite bitter.



chair

You sit on this in school
or when you are tired.



mug

People use this to drink
tea or coffee.



bottles

These are made of glass
and hold drinks in them.



comb

You use this to keep
your hair neat and tidy.



grass

This grows in a garden
and you have to mow it.



leaf

This grows on a tree
but falls off in Autumn.



wool

You use this with needles
to Knit a jumper.



tree

You put decorations on
this at Christmas time.
