

# Mandala Art



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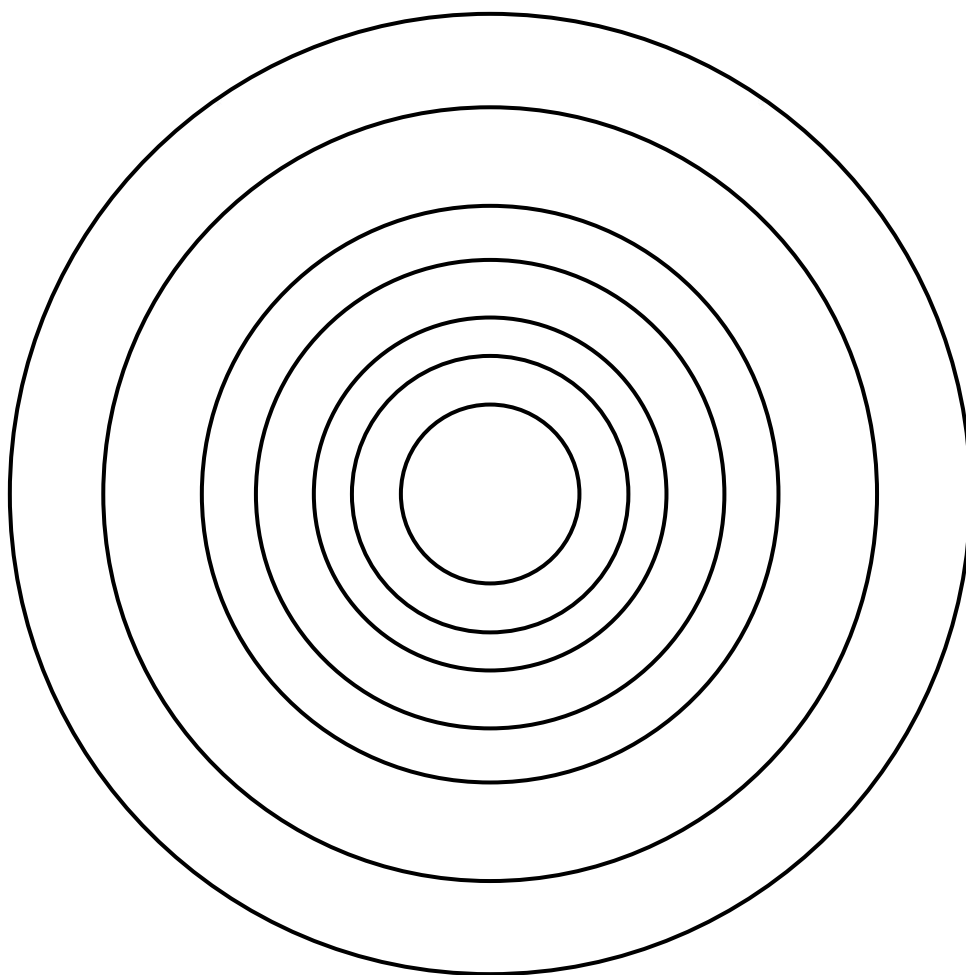
There are no set rules for creating your own mandala art work. However, many mandalas seem to have some things in common. To draw your own mandala, try the following:

- Find the centre point on your drawing page.
- Draw a series of concentric circles based around this midpoint. (Step 1) These circles don't necessarily need to be equidistant
- If you wish, you could draw 4, 6 or 8 straight lines through this midpoint, splitting the circles into sections. (Step 2)
- Then, in between the circles, be creative and imaginative and draw any patterns e.g. dots, circles, leaves, petals, ovals etc.
- Now, colour in your patterns using whatever colour scheme you wish.



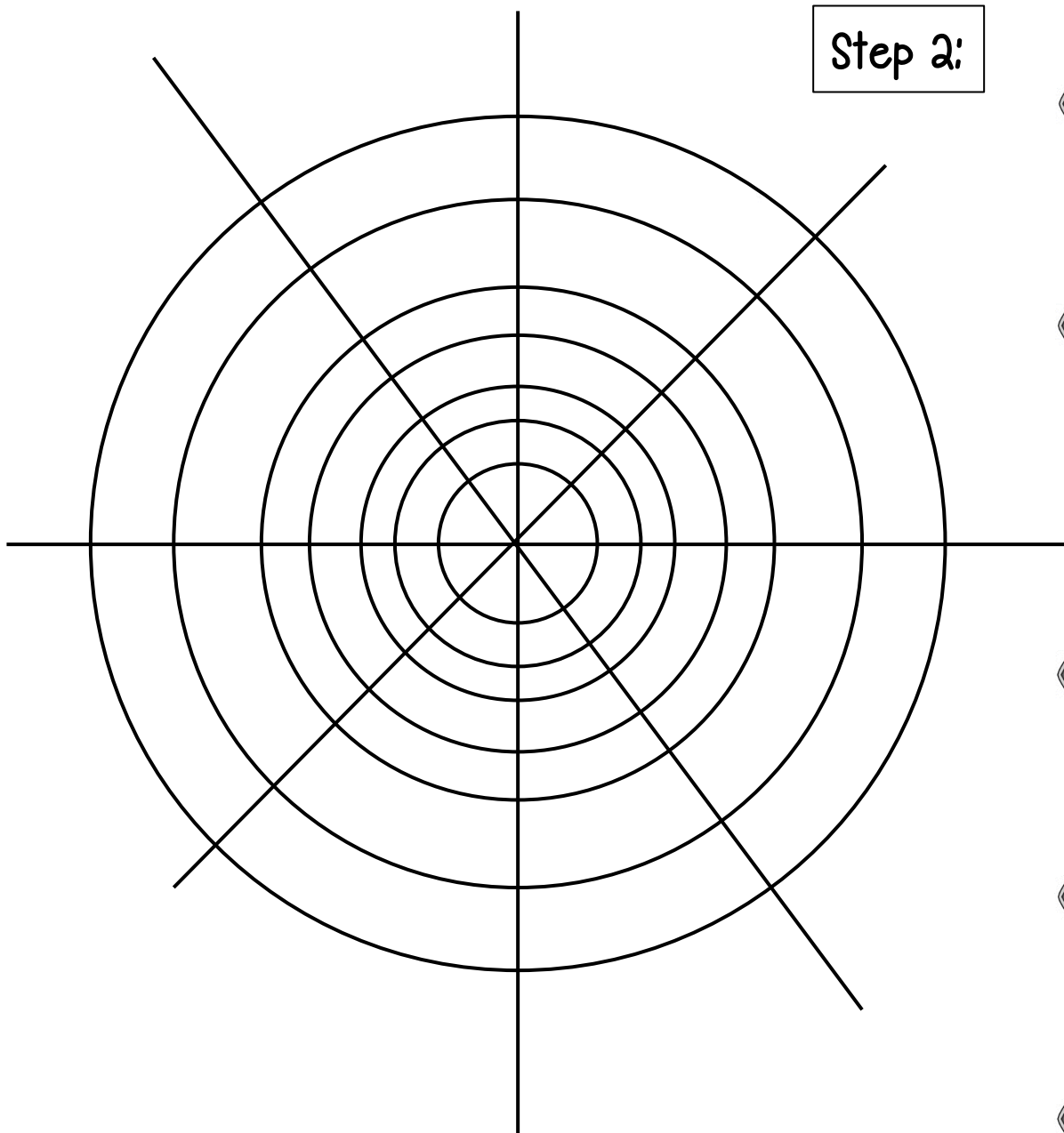

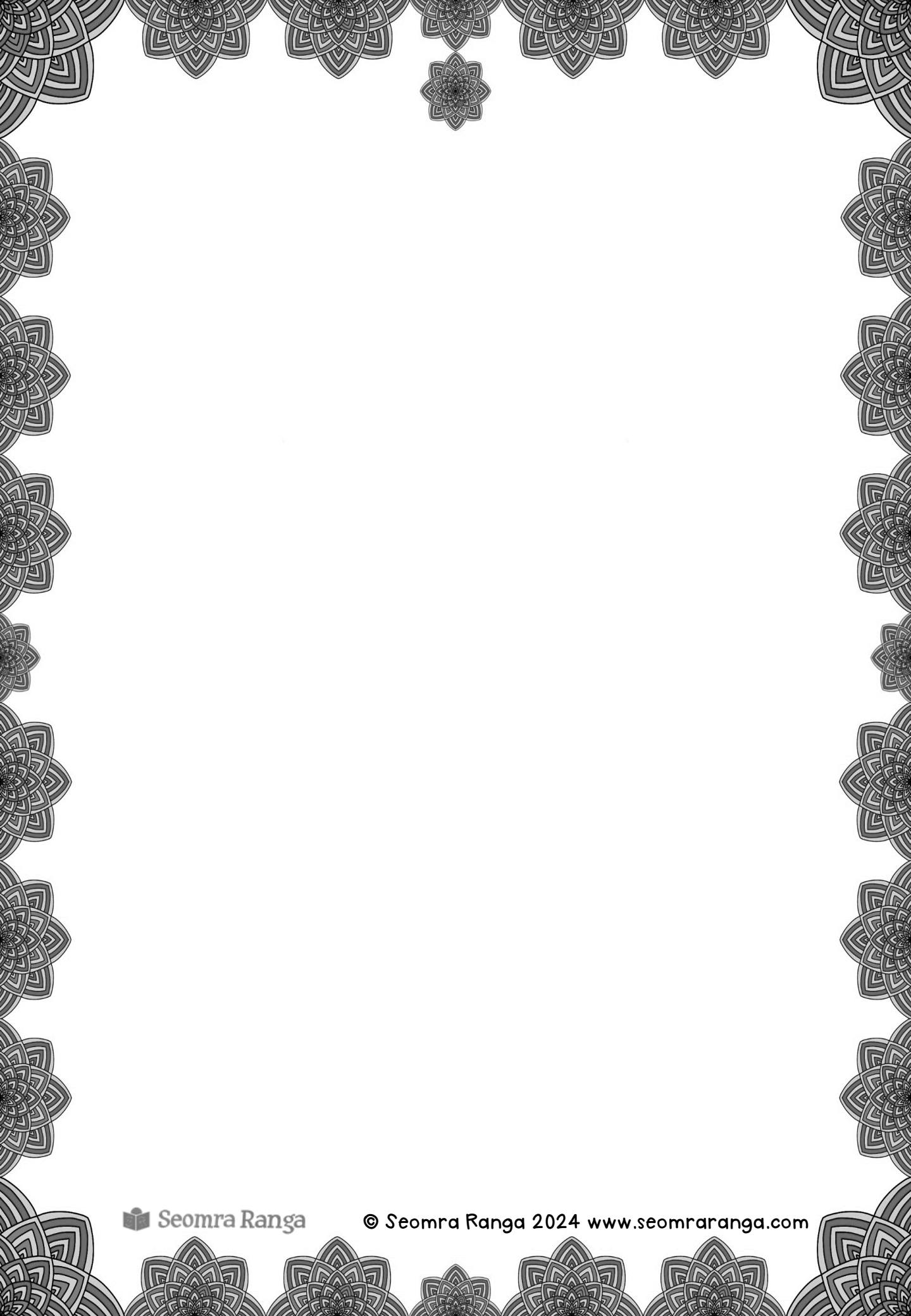
