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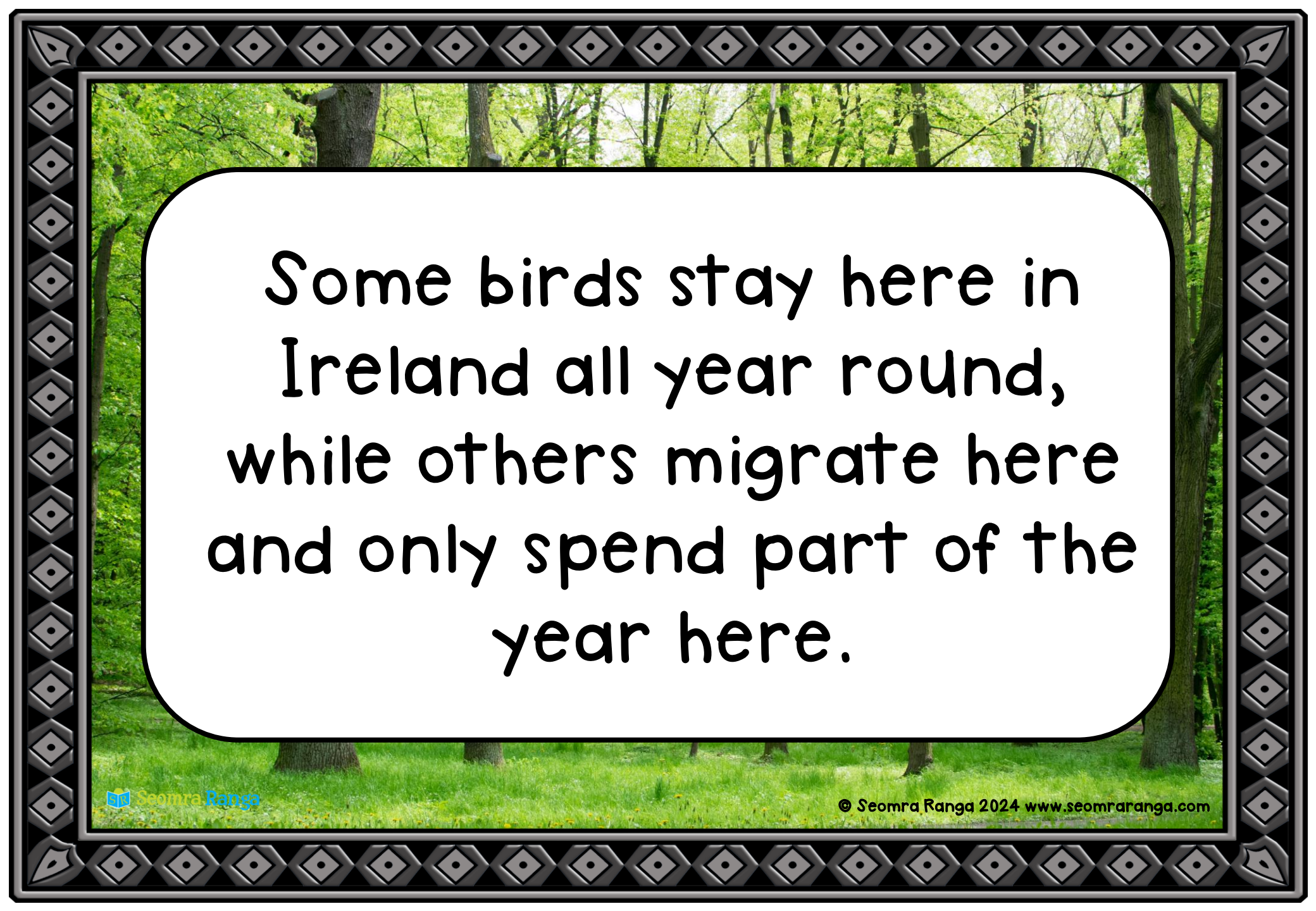
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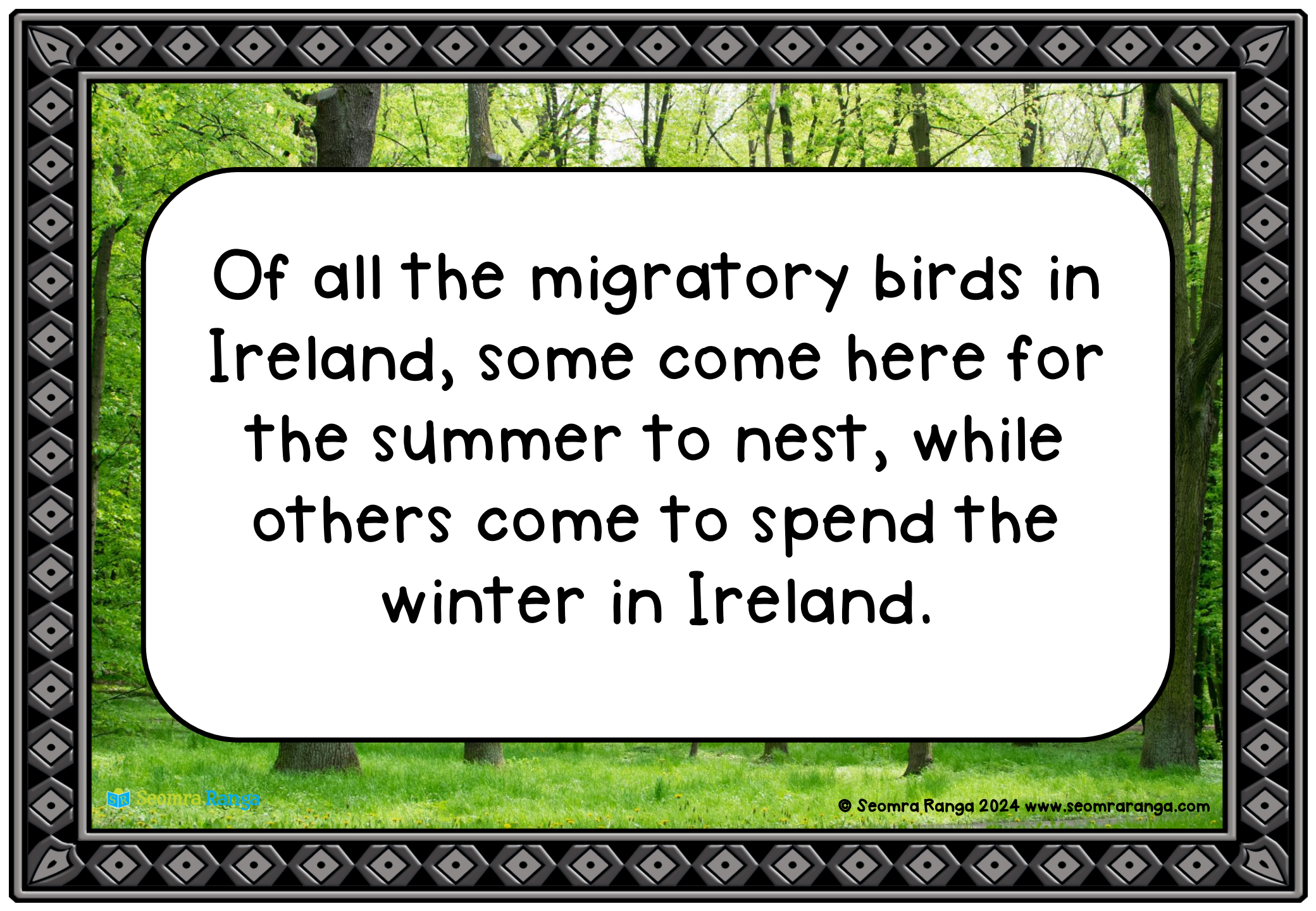
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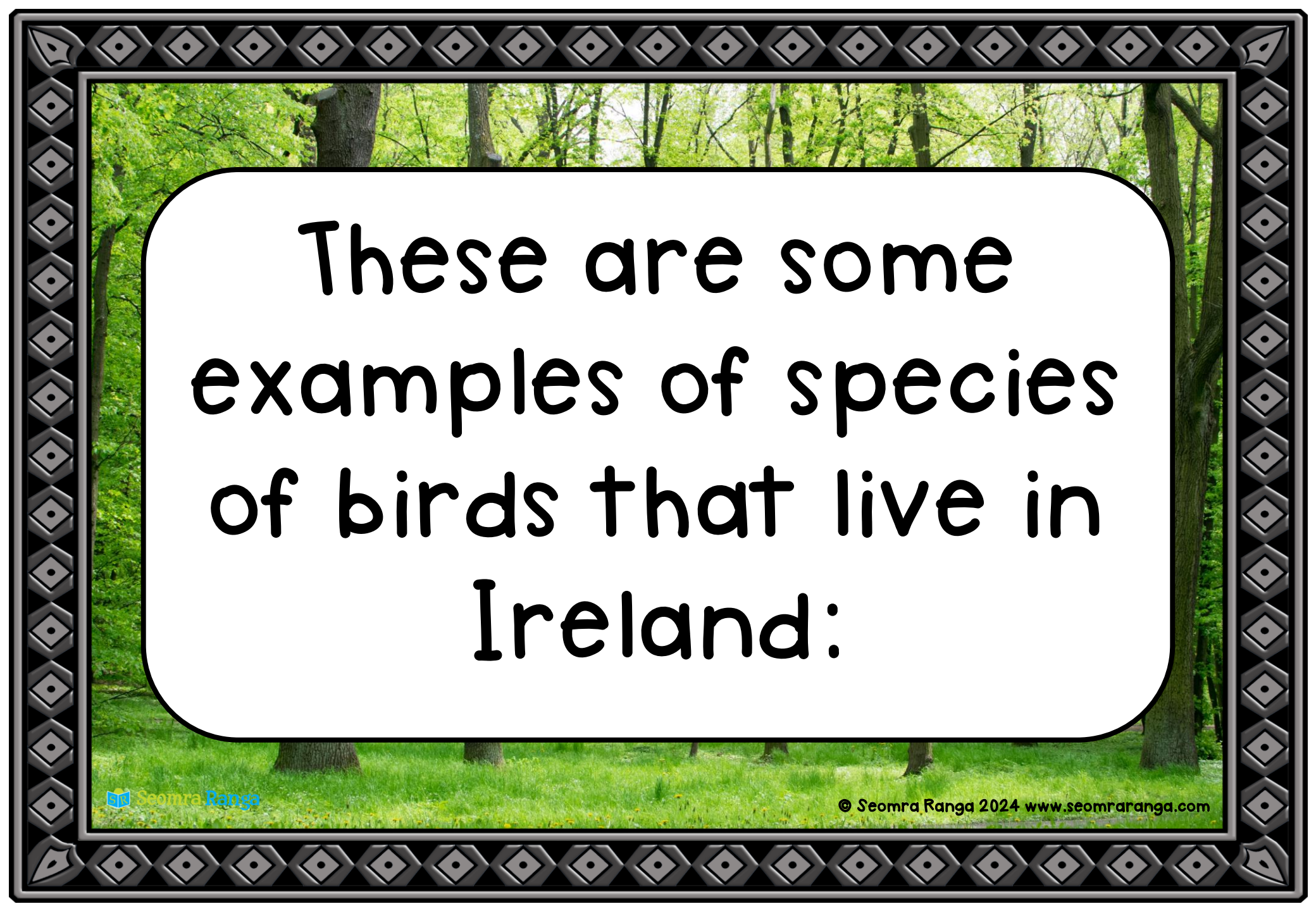
There are about 200 common species of birds in Ireland. If rare species of birds are included, there have been more than 450 species of birds recorded in Ireland.

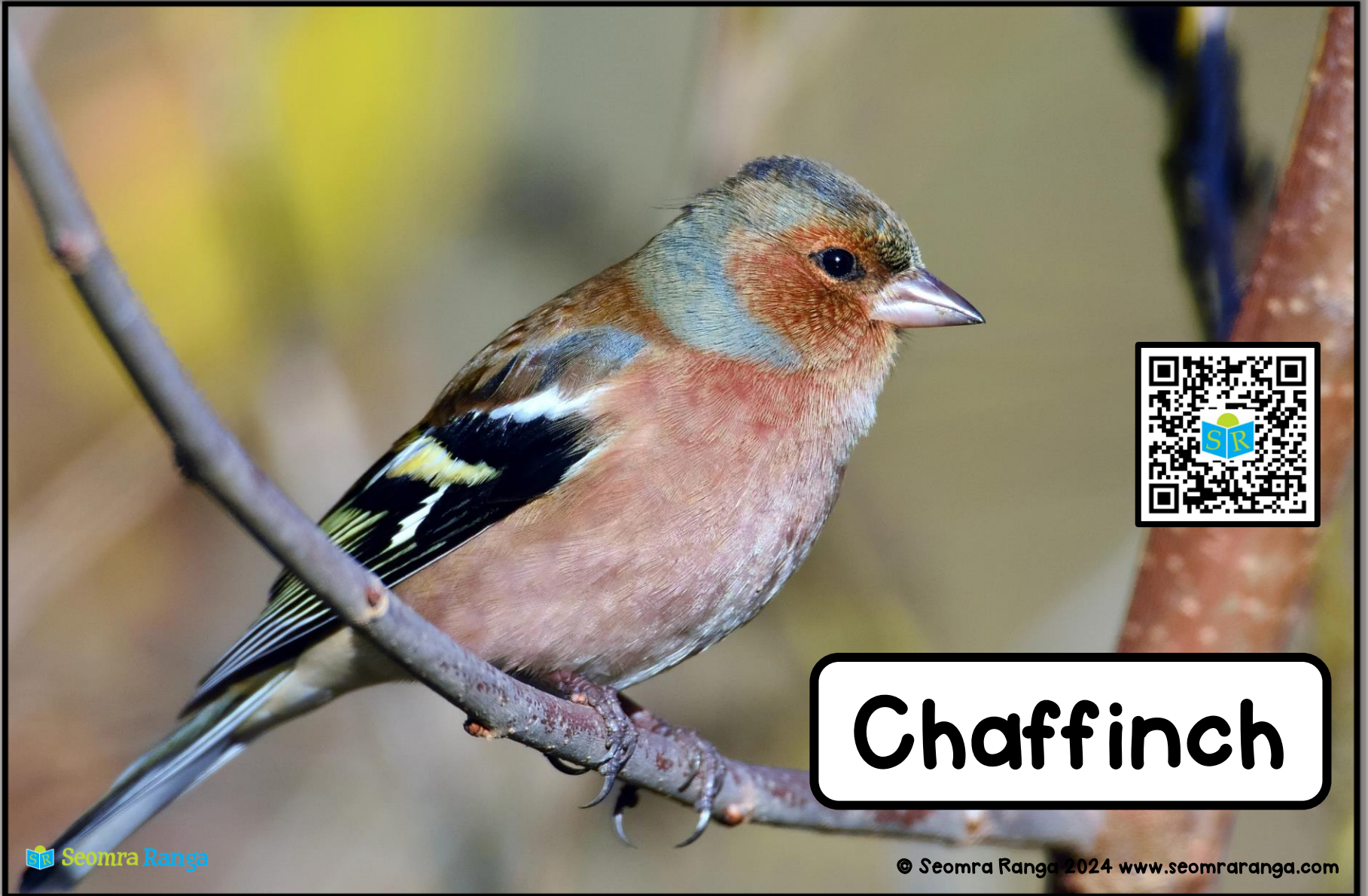
