

# MOTHERS' DAY CARD

This is a really simple and easy art lesson to do, yet it is one which pupils of any age will enjoy.

1. For this lesson, you will need coloured A4 card, matchsticks and coloured paper.
2. Fold the card in half and align horizontally (landscape orientation)
3. To make the flower basket on the front of the card, glue a rough line of vertical matchsticks near the bottom of the card. Glue some sticks underneath the bottom of the basket. Glue a rough semi-circle of matchsticks from one side of the basket to the other to act as the basket handle.
4. Inside the basket, glue some more matchsticks to act as flower stems.
5. Cut out some flowers from coloured paper and stick to the top of the flower stems.
6. When dry, write your Mother's Day greeting inside.
