Directions

Laminate each of the puzzles in this resource. Copy the blank grids on pages 11/12 onto card and laminate them also. For each puzzle, cut it up into twenty pieces. Place Velcro on the top and bottom of the rear of each of these pieces and place a corresponding piece of Velcro in each of the twenty spaces in the blank grid.

When doing this puzzle for the first time, pupils could use the blank numbered grid as a reference to complete the puzzle. Once they become proficient with this, get them to use the completely blank grid.

This activity is really good for spatial awareness and fine motor skills combined with an element of numeracy.
