

Christmas Line-Ups

This resource focuses on ordinal numbers and positional language which can pose some difficulties for younger pupils and SEN pupils.

This pack includes four worksheets for pupils to practise these essential skills. Christmas-themed images have to be cut, practising fine motor skills, and placed in the correct positions using the instructions.

The worksheets include language like first, last, third, before, beside, between.

If the pupils are able, they can read the instructions independently and follow the directions. Alternatively, the teacher can read the directions aloud and pupils follow the directions accordingly.

2. The wreath is third in line.

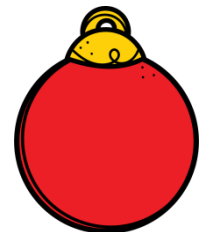
3. The popcorn is next to Santa.

2. The bauble is first in line.

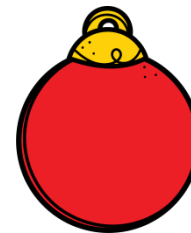
3. The candy cane is last in line.
