
Winter Wonderland

Walkin' in a Winter Wonderland.




Frosty the Snowman

And two eyes made out of coal.


Frosty the Snowman

When Santa Got Stuck Up the Chimney


When Santa got stuck up the chimney,





Then I could wish you Merry Christmas.




Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer

You'll go down in history!"




Santa Claus is Coming to Town





So high above with you.


Far across the world,

Mistletoe and Wine


The child is a King, the carolers sing,

A time for hating and fighting to cease. [Chorus]




Jingle Bell Rock

That's the jingle bell rock.






Merry Christmas Everyone

What a nice way to spend the year.




Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree

To hear those magic reindeer click.


'Cause I just want you here tonight,

With candy canes and silver lanes that glow.


It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas,

Sure, it's Christmas once more.




White Christmas

Without any fear.


